ELIGIBILITY

El Paso community members that have experienced a financial hardship, directly or indirectly, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Eligible individuals include those who:

- · Live within the El Paso City limits.
- Prove financial hardship or loss of income due to COVID-19.
- · Rent their residence within city limits.
- Do not exceed 80 percent of the median household income (AMI).
- · Do not receive duplicate services from any other agency.

THE PROCESS

Our services are offered in English and Spanish and are free of cost. The CRC hours of operation are Monday-Friday 8:30 AM - 6:00 PM. However, we understand your family's busy schedule and will offer extended hours by appointment as needed.
