**ORDER WAIVING TRAFFIC FINE FOR CONVICTION OF CERTAIN INTOXICATED
DRIVER OFFENSES**

This Court convicted the above Defendant today of an offense subject to an additional fine under TEX. TRANSP. CODE Ch. 709.001. The Defendant has provided evidence to the Court establishing indigence as follows:

- a copy of his/her most recent federal income tax return reflecting personal or household income that does not exceed 125 percent of the applicable income level established by federal poverty guidelines;
- a copy of his/her most recent wage statement reflecting personal or household income that does not exceed 125 percent of the applicable income level established by federal poverty guidelines;
- federal agency, state agency, or school district documentation indicating that he/she (or the taxpayer claiming him/her as a "dependent," as defined by Section 152, Internal Revenue Code of 1986) receives assistance from:
 - (A) the food stamp program or the financial assistance program established under Chapter 31, Human Resources Code;
 - (B) the federal special supplemental nutrition program for women, infants, and children authorized by 42 U.S.C. § 1786;
 - (C) the medical assistance program under TEX. HUM. RES. CODE Ch. 32;
 - (D) the child health plan program under TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE Ch. 62; or
 - (E) the national free or reduced-price lunch program established under 42 U.S.C. § 1751 et seq.;
- the Court previously received evidence, found the Defendant indigent, appointed counsel for the purposes of this case, and finds that status is unchanged; or
- the Defendant provided testimony to establish his/her indigence.

Therefore, the Court finds that Defendant is indigent and, pursuant to TEX. TRANSP. CODE § 709.001, ORDERS that the Texas Department of Public Safety **WAIVE** all traffic fines for conviction of certain intoxicated driver offenses that would otherwise be assessed under Chapter 709.001 as a result of the conviction in this case.
